Discovery Day Camp

When: June 15—June 19

For kids having completed Kindergarten, First, or Second Grade.

Campers Arrive between 8:30 and 9:00am each day and must be picked up between 5:30 and 6:00pm daily.

Campers should bring their own sack lunch every day. GH will provide lunch each day for an additional cost

New to camp: Introduction to overnight camping. Thursday June 18 we are allowing kids and their parents to stay overnight if they want. This lets you and your child see what overnight camping is like in a fun comfortable environment.

Adventure Camp

When: June 21—June 26

For kids having completed Third, Fourth, or Fifth Grade.

Campers arrive between 3:30 and 4:30pm Sunday, and must be picked up at 12:00 (noon) Friday.

Camp week is an adventure of the mind, body, and soul. Everyday starts with praise and a theme for the day. Campers will learn songs and at least one bible passage which matches the theme for the day.

Activities include: boating, hiking, swimming, arts and crafts, skits, athletics, orienteering, personal reflection, bible study, daily campfire and much more.

Extreme Camp

When: June 28—July 3

For kids having completed Sixth, Seventh, or Eighth Grade.

Campers arrive between 3:30 and 4:30pm Sunday, and must be picked up at 12:00 (noon) Friday.
